



# INFORMATION NEEDED FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

1. GPA
2. High School Transcript or most recent grading period's progress report if attending a post-secondary institution.
3. ACT or SAT score (for Lippitt Perseverance Only)
4. List of academic honors, awards and membership/club activities while in school
5. List of hobbies, outside interests, extracurricular activities, volunteer activities and/or employment
6. Name and location of school you will be attending in the fall
7. Your planned Major
8. How will attending a college/university/trade school, etc. help you to realize your plans for the future
9. If awarded a scholarship, for what will you use the funds. Scholarships must be used for school related expenses and will not be paid to the individual scholarship winner. If the funds will be paid to an entity other than the school to which the scholarship awardee will attend, please explain how and why this request relates to post-secondary schooling and how it will help you be successful in school.
10. Essay (minimum of 250 words)
